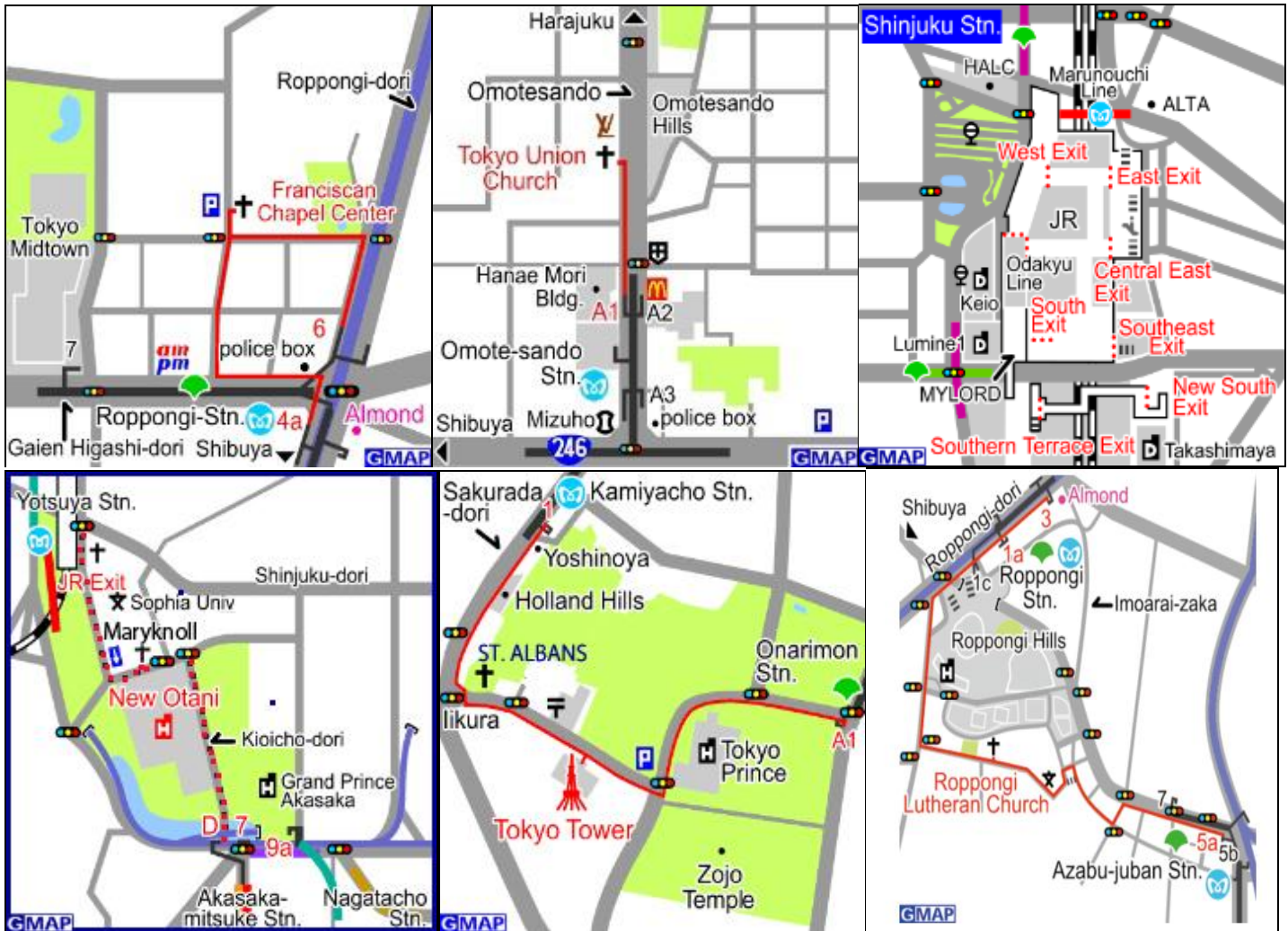

1. **Franciscan Chapel Center [FCC]:** Take the Hibiya Subway Line to Roppongi. Exit 4A. It is less than a 10 minute walk. Ask at the Police Box for the Franciscan Chapel Center if you need help.
2. **Tokyo Union Church [TUC]:** Please note: McDonalds is no longer at the location shown on the map above. Between the Harajuku Station (JR) and the Omotesando Subway Station (Ginza, Chiyoda and Hanzomon Lines). The entrance is on the side street, through the garage--the main door is usually closed. Meeting is on the second floor.
3. **Shinjuku:** West exit of JR. Stay underground. Walk through the underground passage to the end, near the 58-story Mitsui Building—in the outside courtyard. If bad weather—call Ian, 080-4629, Patricia I, 090-2145-2399, or Martin at 090-1217-0937
4. **Maryknoll:** Take the Kojimachi Exit from Yotsuya Station, at the top of the stairs turn right and cross the street. Cross the street again, toward your left. You will be facing a brown round-shaped building. Turn right and follow the road until it ends. Turn left there, at Kioi Concert Hall. Maryknoll is the second building on the left, directly across from the Hotel New Otani.
5. **St. Andrews:** From Kamiya-cho station, walk up-hill and then towards Tokyo Tower. From Akabanebashi or Onarimon, just go up to Tokyo Tower. The meeting is in the St. Andrew's stand-alone hall, to the left of St. Andrews's church, which is to the left of St. Alban's church. It is the building furthest to the LEFT in this two-church campus..
6. **Roppongi Lutheran Church:** From Roppongi station walk down Roppongi Dori to Roppongi Hills complex. Walk straight through Roppongi Hills with TokyoTower on your left side. Go down escalators and you will see the church, there is a large illuminated cross on the roof. Meeting is on the third floor. Doors open at 19:00 and meetings start at 19:30
7. **Club 508/Minamino Miracle Group :** (no Map) Location: JR Hashimoto station/ Keio Hashimoto station. From Shinjuku station take the Chuo line for Takao. Get off at Hachioji and transfer to Yokohama line, go four stops to Hashimoto. At Hashimoto, exit the ticket gates, turn right and walk straight past MeWe shopping mall, veer left. Take the stairs on the **left** down. Walk straight for several blocks. When you come to a large intersection (LEO Palace 21 is there), cross it and continue walking straight. Go past the bus stop, and the meeting place is in Shalom Koyama building, apartment number 103.

Keio line access: Same as above, except take Keio line from Shinjuku station for Hashimoto. Get off at Hashimoto and follow the corridor until you are **past** the JR Hashimoto ticket gates.
